Healthy Snacks

Please can we remind parents that children are allowed to bring healthy snacks into school to enjoy at breaktime. Our tuck shop will also be starting again from Monday. Suitable foods include fruit and (non-chocolate) cereal bars. Children are not allowed to eat sweets, crisps or chocolate during their morning play. Children in EYFS and KS1 are offered, and are entitled to, a free piece of fruit every day.

According to NHS choices a balanced lunchbox should include:

- Starchy foods like bread, pasta, potatoes or rice
- Protein foods like meat, fish, eggs or beans
- A dairy item like cheese or yogurt
- Vegetables or salad and a piece of fruit

Finally, can we remind parents that children should only be drinking water during the day. This should be in a bottle with a sport's lid. These can be purchased from the school office for £1.20.
