Science key words

States of matter

- Solid- Solids are objects that keep their own shape and do not flow in a given temperature.
- **Liquid-** is a form of matter. It is settled between solid and gas. Liquid has an almost-fixed volume, but no set shape.
- Gas- are air-like substances that can move around freely or they might flow to fit a container.
- Degrees Celsius- is a unit of temperature on the Celsius scale
- Evaporation- when a liquid turns into a gas or vapour we call this evaporation.
- Condensation- is the process by which water vapour (water in its gas form) turns into liquid
- **Temperature-** is a degree of hotness or coldness the can be measured using a thermometer.
- Water vapour- is water that is in the form of a vapor, or gas; for example steam.

Teeth

- Incisors- Your two front teeth and the teeth on either side of them are incisors.
 There are four on the top and four on bottom.
- Canines- The pointy teeth beside your incisors are called canine teeth. There are four of them, two on top and two on bottom.
- **Premolars-** are the teeth between the canines and the molars. There are at most a total of eight of them.
- Molars are large, flat teeth at the back of the mouth and they are used primarily to grind food during chewing.
- Wisdom teeth- are the last adult teeth to come into the mouth. Most people have four wisdom teeth at the back of the mouth

- **Herbivore-** an animal that just eats plants
- Carnivore- an animal that feeds on other animals
