M Dear Parents and Carers

It is such a lovely time of year in the school when the children start to get excited about Christmas. I am

delighted that this year we are one of 17 schools in Cornwall to be singing and performing the Pirate FM Christmas song. Our song is day 15 and will be played on Pirate FM at 8.15am on the morning of 10th December, the video will also be shown on their website on the day. We are really exited that the children will be filmed singing the song on Friday 22nd November. We will ask the children to wear Christmas hats on the day with their school uniform.
