We welcome you back to the start of the Summer Term, where all the children have been very busy challenging themselves in their learning.

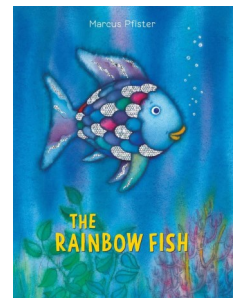
This term we are introducing our new topic 'All creatures great and small.' We will start by investigating different sea creatures and will find out lots of information about them too.

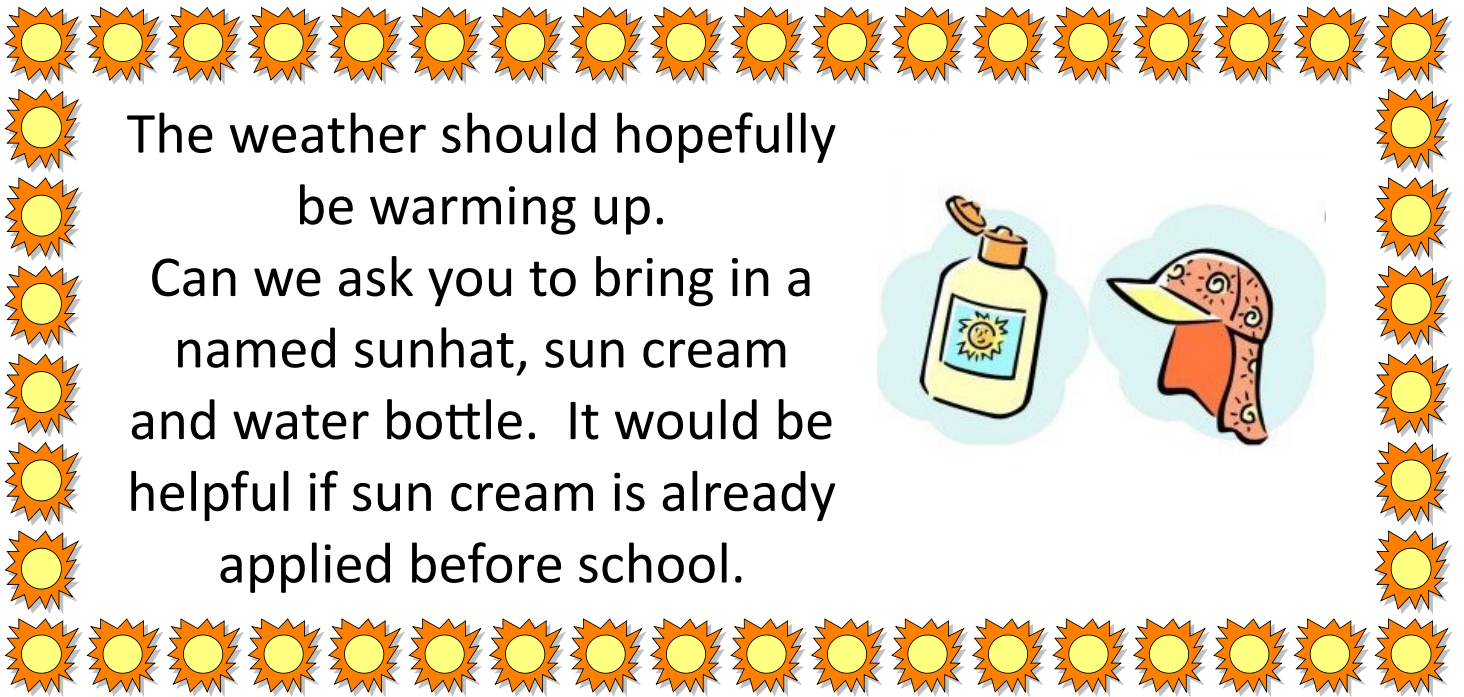
Reception - Show and Tell
